What is the MaRDI Knowledge Graph?

A knowledge graph that connects many mathematical sources, such as publications, datasets, or software. It helps show how mathematical ideas and tools connect, making research easier to explore and understand.

Who is this service for?

For researchers and math enthusiasts who want an easy way to explore mathematical information and understand how different parts of mathematics relate and work together.

Why should I use it?

Because it helps you discover and connect mathematical knowledge – revealing relationships between data, tools, and research that inspire new insights and collaborations.

It can also help make your work more visible, making it easier for others to find and access.
